I have a number of reservations with the thrust and emphasis of suggested responses 2, 4, 5, 6 and 9. I will raise these issues with Members when this report is debated and have in the interim responded to Gary Alexander on matters of detail. It is my view that the JSPU needs to respond in the context of the potential implications of the NPPF on local-plan delivery. It might well be the case that the implications of the NPPF need to be considered separately by each Council in the context of development management and local decision-making until such time as both the NPPF is embedded and the Joint Local Plan is in place.'
